RESOLUTION: A) ACCEPTING THE CERTIFICATE OF THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER AS THE STATEMENT OF THE RESULTS OF THE VOTE AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICIAL CANVASS OF THE NOVEMBER 8, 2016, PRESIDENTIAL GENERAL ELECTION; B) DECLARING THE PERSONS ELECTED TO CERTAIN OFFICES; AND C) DECLARING THE RESULTS OF CERTAIN MEASURES VOTED ON AT THE ELECTION

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Chief Elections Officer has completed the official canvass of the completed returns of the votes cast at the Presidential General Election held throughout the County of San Mateo on November 8, 2016, has prepared in accordance with law an abstract or Statement of the Votes polled at said election held on said date, and has presented a certified copy of said statement to this Honorable Board; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will deliver a duplicate of the certified statement to the California Secretary of State; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer will deliver to each person elected a certificate of election, signed and authorized by the Chief Elections Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Elections Officer has also determined that only the incumbent filed nomination papers for the listed offices of Superior Court Judge, pursuant to the Elections Code the name of each listed incumbent did not appear on either the primary ballot or general election ballot given the absence of any write-in campaigns, and accordingly the following incumbents have been declared elected by the Chief Elections Officer on November 8, 2016, pursuant to Section 8203 of the Elections Code:
