WHEREAS, CAROLYN LIVENGOOD was also a member of the Veterans Coalition of San Mateo County, and has generously volunteered her time during the past 25 years with the U. S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, Flotilla 15 at Oyster Point where she retired as Commander in 2006, and regularly has given testimony at the Board of Supervisors meetings regarding veterans' issues.

NOW, therefore be it resolved that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County hereby honors and commends **CAROLYN LIVENGOOD** for receiving the 2016 Patriot of the Year Award for her unsurpassed devotion to veteran causes and activities in San Mateo County.
