**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE FY 2016 EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM AWARD, FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1, 2015 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2017, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$23,317.**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, through the U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, supports all components of the criminal justice system and addresses crime through the provision of services directly to individuals and/or communities and by improving the effectiveness and efficiency of criminal justice systems, processes and procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Office applied for and was awarded the FY 2016 JAG in the amount of \$23,317, and a term commencing October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the award will be used toward updating the Sheriff's Office First-Aid/CPR curriculum to comply with the revised Title 22 requirements as well as purchasing new training supplies and equipment to be used in conjunction with the training curriculum; and

**WHEREAS**, the updated training and new supplies and equipment will enhance the effectiveness of law enforcement when responding to emergencies that require the

immediate care of injured and/or ill persons; and

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of San Mateo, hereby accepts the FY 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program in the amount of \$23,317.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents in connection with this grant, including but not limited to, agreements, amendments, and grant assurances.
