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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS AND PARKS, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT A CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS FOUNDATION GRANT FOR THE SAN BRUNO MOUNTAIN BOG TRAIL REVEGETATION AND TRAIL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County owns and operates the San Bruno Mountain
State and County Park; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County would like to remove non-native invasive perennial plants along the Bog Trail and revegetate the newly opened spaces with native plants grown from seed gathered on San Bruno Mountain and repair the split rail fence; and

WHEREAS, the California State Park Foundation implements a discretionary grant program to award small grants to California's state parks, governmental entities or nonprofit organizations working to protect, enhance and preserve State Parks.

Discretionary grants primarily support four of CSPF's core areas of interest: Volunteer Efforts and Recognition, Education and Interpretation, Natural and Cultural Resource Protection, and Capacity-Building; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County will enter into an agreement with the California

State Parks Foundation for development of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Director of Public Works and Parks, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a California State Parks Foundation grant for the San Bruno Mountain Bog Trail Revegetation and Trail Improvement Project in the amount of \$5,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works and Parks, or his designee, is authorized to execute any other documents associated with acceptance of grant funding from the California State Parks Foundation in the amount of \$5,000.

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
