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RESOLUTION:

- A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF 10TH AVENUE, FROM FAIR OAKS AVENUE TO THE END, AND AMHERST AVENUE, FROM EL CAMINO REAL TO GLENDALE AVENUE NORTH FAIR OAKS AREA; AND
 - B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY TUESDAY, JUNE 25, 2013 AT 2:30 P.M., IN THE OFFICE OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on June 18, 2002, adopt Resolution Nos. 065329 and 065330, which established minimum road standard options and a priority list for road improvements in the North Fair Oaks area; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors did, on May 25, 2010 and February 28, 2012, adopt Resolution Nos. 070795 and 071852, respectively, which resolutions approved work plans for utilization of Proposition 1B Transportation Bond funds allocated in FY 2009-10 Appropriation; and

WHEREAS, 10th Avenue, from Fair Oaks Avenue to the End of the road (one block) and Amherst Avenue, from El Camino Real to Glendale Avenue, are the next streets on the North Fair Oaks road priority list for proposed reconstruction and were included in the approved work plan; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications, dated May 31, 2013 have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the reconstruction of 10th Avenue, from Fair Oaks Avenue to the End, and Amherst Avenue from El Camino Real to Glendale Avenue, in the North Fair Oaks Area, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the "plans and specifications"); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- The plans and specifications, dated May 31, 2013, for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.
- 2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.

- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals and to set the bid opening date and time on or before 2:30 p.m., Tuesday, June 25, 2013 in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
- 4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
- 5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
