RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO: A) INITIATE INVESTIGATIONS CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT ALPINE ROAD AND HIGHWAY 280 AND, IF ABLE TO OBTAIN CALTRANS APPROVAL FOR SUCH IMPROVEMENTS, TO PURSUE GRANT FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES WHICH WOULD ALLOW SUCH CONSTRUCTION TO PROCEED; AND B) CEASE WORK ON A TRUCK BAN ON ALPINE ROAD

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of

California, that

WHEREAS, Alpine Road at the Highway280 intersection is heavily congested

during commute hours; and

WHEREAS, traffic analysis previously performed confirms that the installation

of traffic signals at the Alpine Road/ Highway 280 intersection will significantly improve

traffic circulation at this location; and

WHEREAS, traffic signals at Alpine Road and Highway 280 will also improve

spacing along Alpine Road, providing improved opportunities for residents living along

or immediately adjacent to Alpine Road, to enter Alpine Road; and

WHEREAS, a truck ban previously contemplated, would not provide these same benefits: and

WHEREAS, Caltrans has jurisdiction over this intersection and approval

authority over any contemplated projects; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County, as an adjoining agency can request that Caltrans allow the County to sponsor improvements approved by Caltrans

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation to authorize the Director of Public Works to initiate investigations concerning the installation of traffic signals, to pursue grant funding, and cease work on a truck ban along Alpine Road.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to initiate investigations concerning the installation of traffic signals at Alpine Road and Highway 280 and pursue grant funding pending Caltrans approval and to cease work on a truck ban along Alpine Road.
