RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE DESIGNATION OF THE 174-ACRE OFFICE OF EDUCATION LOMA MAR PROPERTY AS A PRIORITY CONSERVATION AREA BY THE ASSOCIATION OF BAY AREA GOVERNMENTS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County considers improvements and expansions to its existing County Parks System on an ongoing basis; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Education Loma Mar property lies adjacent to Memorial County Park within the San Mateo County Park System; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Park System's future acquisition of the Office of Education Loma Mar property may be eligible for partial funding by the Plan Bay Area Priority Conservation Area (PCA) grant program; and

WHEREAS, such partial funding by the PCA grant program would require that the Association of Bay Area Governments, under Plan Bay Area, designate the area covered by the Office of Education Loma Mar property as a Priority Conservation Area; and

WHEREAS, support by this Board of Supervisors for such a designation is important to the designation process.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the County of San Mateo is in full support of the designation of the area covered by the Office of Education Loma Mar property as a Priority Conservation Area by the Association of Bay Area Governments.
