RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH TEAM UP TUTORS, INCORPORATED FOR TUTORING SERVICES, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY \$120,000 TO \$210,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2012, the Human Services Agency approved

Agreement #74200-13-D003 with Team Up Tutor Incorporated for Tutoring Services for the term July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2015 in the amount of \$90,000; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency Children and Family Services has seen a 17% increase in referral of foster youths in the system showing academic weakness; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency wishes to amend the Agreement to increase the amount of the Agreement by \$120,000 to \$210,000 for Team Up Tutors to continue providing tutoring services to foster youths who have entered the child welfare system with a history of academic challenges; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to enter into an Amendment to the Agreement with Team Up Tutors as they were originally selected to provide services for the entire San Mateo County geographic area, including the coastal region; and continue to provide effective tutorial services to foster youth to achieve academic

success in high school and increase graduation percentage.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

- A. President of this Board of Supervisors be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute said Amendment to the Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto; and
- B. Director of the Human Services Agency (HSA) or the Director's designee is hereby authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
