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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH CORA TO PROVIDE EMERGENCY RESPONSE PROGRAM SERVICES TO SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2013 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2014, IN AN NOT TO EXCEED \$132,610

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, CORA (Community Overcoming Relationship Abuse) has been providing victims and survivors of domestic violence with a complete range of prevention, education, and intervention services for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, CORA's Emergency Response Program is the only program to collaborate with all law enforcement agencies in the County, providing 24-hour telephone counseling support during or immediately following a 911 domestic violence disturbance call; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Domestic Violence Protocol, adopted in 2004, provides for notification to the Emergency Response Program when handling incidents involving any type of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, since CORA is the only agency in the County that provides comprehensive services to victims and survivors of domestic violence, it is in the County's best interest to waive the Request for Proposals process and enter into a

contract for Emergency Response Program services; and

WHEREAS, the contract with CORA for Emergency Response Program services is for a one-year term commencing July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014, and for an amount not to exceed \$132,610; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of said agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Request for Proposals process is hereby waived.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the Board be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee is hereby authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
