WHEREAS, COMMANDER NOREEN HANLON grew up in San Bruno, attended Saint Roberts School, graduated from Mercy Burlingame High School, received her Associate Degree from Skyline College and attended Notre Dame de Namur University where she earned a Baccalaureate Degree in Human Services, and received a Master’s Degree in Emergency Services from Long Beach State University; and

WHEREAS, COMMANDER NOREEN HANLON began her career with the San Bruno Police Department in 1984 after attending the Police Academy in Butte County, and during the early part of her career served as the Youth Service Officer, D.A.R.E Officer, Field Training Officer and Corporal, and was promoted to Sergeant in 2000. She was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant in 2002 and to Commander in 2007 when she served as the Department’s Second in Command; and

WHEREAS, in addition to her extensive experience, COMMANDER NOREEN HANLON served as the Department’s Peer Support Coordinator, Tactical Communication instructor and also as an instructor at the South Bay Regional Police Academy in San Mateo. Commander Hanlon also attained the Advanced, Supervisory and Management Certificates from the State of California, Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training.
