**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.61.010 AND 2.63.010 OF  
ARTICLE 2.6 OF TITLE 2 OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE,  
WHICH ESTABLISH THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND THE  
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION, RESPECTIVELY**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,

ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2.61.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code is

hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

**Section 2.61.010. Planning Commission.**

There is in the County a Planning Commission consisting of five members, who shall not be officials or employees of the County of San Mateo. The five members shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. One member shall reside in each supervisorial district and members shall reside in the district of their appointment during their term. These residency requirements may be waived by the Board of Supervisors if it finds such waiver to be in the public interest. In the event that the Board of Supervisors waives the requirement that one member reside in each supervisorial district, reasonable effort shall be made to seek appointees from areas as geographically near as practicable to the district that lacks a resident member. However, in no event shall more than two (2) members reside in the same supervisorial district.

The term of office for each member shall be four years. The term for a member shall coincide with the term of office of the Supervisor representing the member's district of appointment. When a Supervisor vacates office for any reason, the term of the member appointed from the same district shall also be vacated, except that said member may continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Members are limited to three consecutive full terms of office. For purposes of determining the number of consecutive terms that a member may serve, any person appointed to fill a vacancy on the Commission will be considered to have served a full term if there are two or more years remaining in the term to which appointed, determined as of the date of

appointment to fill the vacancy; and any person appointed to fill a vacancy on the Commission with less than two years remaining in the term as of the date of appointment will not be considered to have served a full term.

SECTION 2. Section 2.63.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

**Section 2.63.010. Commissions, members, and terms.**

There is established a Parks and Recreation Commission, which shall consist of five members, appointed by and serving at the pleasure of the Board of Supervisors. One member shall reside in each supervisorial district and members shall reside in the district of their appointment during their term. These residency requirements may be waived by the Board of Supervisors if it finds such waiver to be in the public interest. In the event that the Board of Supervisors waives the requirement that one member reside in each supervisorial district, reasonable effort shall be made to seek appointees from areas as geographically near as practicable to the district that lacks a resident member. However, in no event shall more than two (2) members reside in the same supervisorial district.

The term of office for each member shall be four years. The term for a member shall coincide with the term of office of the Supervisor representing the member's district of appointment. When a Supervisor vacates office for any reason, the term of the member appointed from the same district shall also be vacated, except that said member may continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Board of Supervisors. Members are limited to three consecutive full terms of office. For purposes of determining the number of consecutive terms that a member may serve, any person appointed to fill a vacancy on the Commission will be considered to have served a full term if there are two or more years remaining in the term to which appointed, determined as of the date of appointment to fill the vacancy; and any person appointed to fill a vacancy on the Commission with less than two years remaining in the term as of the date of appointment to fill the vacancy, will not be considered to have served a full term.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of passage thereof.
