**Subject:** Reappointment to the Association of Bay Area Governments

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommendation for the reappointment of Supervisor Warren Slocum and Supervisor Dave Pine to the Association of Bay Area Governments for the July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2016 term.

**BACKGROUND:**

ABAG was established in 1961 and is the oldest Council of Governments in California. It is the designated regional planning agency for the San Francisco Bay Area and its members include all nine counties and approximately 100 cities in the region. ABAG addresses land use, housing, environmental quality and economic development issues.

**DISCUSSION:**

The ABAG Board recommends the annual budget and summary work programs of the Association for adoption by the General Assembly; appoints, fixes the salary of, and removes the Executive Director; acts on recommendations from committees for policy decisions and carries out policy decisions made by the General Assembly. Representatives and alternates from member counties are appointed by that County's Board of Supervisors.
