WHEREAS, in 2011, the County's Board of Supervisors did adopt the San Mateo County 2011 Facility Master Plan (Plan); and

**WHEREAS**, the findings and recommendations of said Plan remain valid and desirable; and

**WHEREAS**, the County's business, resources and opportunities are dynamic and evolving; and

WHEREAS, County leadership has prioritized implementation of certain aspects of the 2011 Master Plan, namely the relocation of County staff from leased properties onto County-owned facilities, the Countywide application of space standards the consolidation of related functions within facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, Measure A funding has been allocated in the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a copy of the aforementioned "2014 Government Center Development Strategy" and has examined and approved same as to both form and content, and desires to proceed with its implementation.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors accepts the 2014 Government Center Development Strategy for the Redwood City Campus.
