* * * * * * RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO SUSTAINABLE GREEN BUILDING POLICY
RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of
California, that

WHEREAS, in 2001, this Board adopted a Sustainable Building Policy that required, to the extent practicable, the construction of LEED-certified San Mateo County facilities and buildings; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, this Board adopted Ordinance No. 04411, which established a Green Building Program for the County and required that new building and major remodels within the unincorporated area of the County be LEED-certified or the functional equivalent of 50 green points or more from Build It Green; and

WHEREAS, the State of California subsequently adopted Green Building Standards, commonly referred to as the CALGreen program; and

WHEREAS, this Board has adopted the CALGreen program standards for the County and has rescinded the requirements of Ordinance No. 04411; and

WHEREAS, this Board seeks to reaffirm its commitment to green building practices and compliance with the LEED certification standard with respect to County facilities and buildings; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board a Sustainable Green Building Policy and the Board has reviewed it and wishes to adopt it.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Sustainable Green Building Policy is hereby adopted by this Board on behalf of the County of San Mateo.
