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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMPACT PARKING
ZONE AT 2119 SANTA CRUZ AVENUE, IN WEST MENLO PARK**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22505 et. al. and Section 7.46 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to determine and declare those parking zones or parking spaces, upon the public highways over which the County has jurisdiction, which are restricted to compact vehicles in order to prevent obstruction of vehicular and pedestrian traffic and to maintain the safe and efficient flow of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the County's public highways; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works shall cause to be marked upon the surface of the pavement, by lines, markings, curbs, or other practical manner, the size and limits of any parking spaces restricted for compact cars or smaller vehicles, and shall also mark upon the surface of the pavement the designation "Compact"; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a compact parking zone be established as noted herein; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs in the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. A compact parking zone be established at the following location:

- 2119 Santa Cruz Avenue (County Road No. 70-A), West Menlo Park.

On the easterly side of SANTA CRUZ AVENUE commencing at a point approximately 318 feet north of the center line of Palo Alto Way and extending north 16 feet, more or less.

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
