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AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2.02.020, 2.02.030, 2.02.040, 2.02.050 AND 2.02.060 OF CHAPTER 2.02, OF TITLE 2 OF THE SAN MATEO COUNTY ORDINANCE CODE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS

The Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California,

ORDAINS as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2.02.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.02.020. First Supervisorial District:

The First Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the northern border of South San Francisco, the Bay, and the County border, and proceeding westerly along the northern border of South San Francisco to El Camino Real; thence proceeding southerly along El Camino Real to the border of the City of San Bruno; thence proceeding westerly along the border of the City of San Bruno to Pacifica; thence proceeding southerly along the border of Pacifica past Sneath Lane to the border of San Bruno; thence proceeding southerly along the borders of San Bruno, Millbrae, and Burlingame to Hillsborough; thence proceeding easterly along the border of Burlingame to Humboldt St; thence proceeding southeasterly along Humboldt St to Poplar Ave; thence proceeding southwesterly along Poplar Ave to the railroad; thence proceeding southeasterly along the railroad to E 5th Ave; thence proceeding northeasterly along E 5th Ave to Interstate 101; thence proceeding southerly along I-101 to Newbridge Ave; thence proceeding northeasterly along Newbridge to S Norfolk St; thence proceeding southerly along Norfolk to Dale Ave; thence proceeding easterly along Dale Ave to Shoreview Ave; thence proceeding southerly along Shoreview Ave to Kehoe Ave; thence proceeding easterly along Kehoe Ave to Crestview Dr; thence proceeding northerly along Crestview Dr to the Bay inlet marking the north border of Bayside/Joinville Park and the Bayside

S.T.E.M. Academy; thence following the inlet to its mouth on the larger Bay inlet; thence following the shoreline north to E 3rd Ave; thence proceeding easterly on E 3rd Ave across the Bay inlet; thence following the shoreline northeasterly to the border of Foster City and San Mateo; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the border of San Mateo and Foster City to County border in the Bay; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the County border to the point of beginning; and depicted in a map that can be viewed in the County Offices.

SECTION 2. Section 2.02.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.02.030. Second Supervisorial District:

The Second Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the borders of San Carlos, Redwood City, and Belmont; thence proceeding westerly along the border of Belmont to San Mateo; thence proceeding northerly along the border of San Mateo to Hillsborough; thence proceeding northerly along the border of Hillsborough to Burlingame; thence proceeding westerly along the border of Burlingame to Humboldt St; thence proceeding southeasterly along Humboldt St to Poplar Ave; thence proceeding southwesterly along Poplar Ave to the railroad; thence proceeding southeasterly along the railroad to E 5th Ave; thence proceeding northeasterly along E 5th Ave to Interstate 101; thence proceeding southerly along I-101 to Newbridge Ave; thence proceeding northeasterly along Newbridge to S Norfolk St; thence proceeding southerly along Norfolk to Dale Ave; thence proceeding easterly along Dale Ave to Shoreview Ave; thence proceeding southerly along Shoreview Ave to Kehoe Ave; thence proceeding easterly along Kehoe Ave to Crestview Dr; thence proceeding northerly along Crestview Dr to the Bay inlet marking the north border of Bayside/Joinville Park and the Bayside S.T.E.M. Academy; thence following the inlet to its mouth on the larger Bay inlet; thence following the shoreline north to E 3rd Ave; thence proceeding easterly on E 3rd Ave across the Bay inlet; thence following the shoreline northeasterly to the border of Foster City and San Mateo; thence proceeding clockwise along the border of Foster City to Belmont: thence proceeding clockwise along the border of Belmont to the point of beginning; and depicted in a map that can be viewed in the County Offices.

SECTION 3. Section 2.02.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.02.040 Third Supervisorial District:

The Third Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that

territory of San Mateo County described as follows:

Beginning in Menlo Park at the intersection of the County border and El Camino Real; thence proceeding northerly along El Camino Real to Valparaiso and the border of Menlo Park; thence proceeding counterclockwise along the border of Menlo Park to Bay Rd and the border of Atherton; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the border of Atherton to El Camino Real and Redwood City; thence proceeding clockwise along the border of Redwood City to the intersection of the borders of Redwood City, San Carlos, and Belmont; thence proceeding westerly along the border of Belmont to San Mateo; thence proceeding northerly along the border of San Mateo to Hillsborough; thence proceeding northerly along the border of Hillsborough to Burlingame; thence proceeding northerly along the western borders of Burlingame, Millbrae and San Bruno to Pacifica; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the border of Pacifica to the County border; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the County border to the point of beginning; and depicted in a map that can be viewed in the County Offices.

SECTION 4. Section 2.02.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.02.050. Fourth Supervisorial District:

The Fourth Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County described as follows:

Beginning in Menlo Park at the intersection of the County border and El Camino Real; thence proceeding northerly along El Camino Real to Valparaiso and the border of Menlo Park; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the border of Menlo Park to Bay Rd and the border of Atherton; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the border of Atherton to El Camino Real and Redwood City; thence proceeding clockwise along the border of Redwood City to the County border; thence proceeding clockwise along the County border to the point of beginning; and depicted in a map that can be viewed in the County Offices.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> Section 2.176.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2.176.060. Fifth Supervisorial District:

The Fifth Supervisorial District of the County of San Mateo, State of California, is hereby established and declared to be and contain all that territory of San Mateo County described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the County's western border, the Pacific Ocean, and the southern border of Daly City; thence proceeding easterly and southerly along the border of Daly City to the intersection of the

borders of Daly City, Pacifica, and South San Francisco; thence proceeding southerly and easterly along the border of South San Francisco to El Camino Real; thence proceeding northerly along El Camino Real to the northern border of South San Francisco; thence proceeding easterly along the border of South San Francisco to the County border; thence proceeding counter-clockwise along the County border to the point of beginning; and depicted in a map that can be viewed in the County Offices.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days from the date of passage thereof.

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
