Smith's outstanding performance has been recognized with over 100 Unit Citations, Letters of Appreciation and Letters of Compliment, most notably when, in 1990, he received the Heroism Award from the Daly City Police Department after the capture of an armed suspect. Sergeant Gary D. Smith was also the recipient of awards from the Peninsula Peace Officers Association and the Peninsula Lions Club; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Gary D. Smith has made significant contributions to the safety and well-being of the residents of Daly City and the entire San Mateo County community.
