RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FROM MILLS-PENINSULA HEALTH SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JANUARY 1, 2014 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2016, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$600,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC) has successfully reduced the number of new patients awaiting access to primary care by 67% over the last 10 months; and

WHEREAS, SMMC still experiences significant numbers of established primary care patients going to its Emergency Department for conditions that could be appropriately addressed in primary care; and

WHEREAS, Mills-Peninsula Health Services has generously agreed to provide a grant of \$200,000 per year to the County for up to three years in order to allow SMMC to expand urgent care services at one of its clinics as outlined in more detail below; and

WHEREAS, with this grant, SMMC proposes to expand access to urgent care in its Daly City Clinic (DCC) by establishing an urgent care team onsite; and

WHEREAS, utilizing this model, SMMC expects to reduce Time to Third Next Available Appointment (TTNAA) at the DCC from the current 14 day average to less

WHEREAS, SMMC also expects to reduce the number of established medical home patients from the DCC seeking care at the SMMC Emergency Department for ambulatory sensitive conditions; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with, examined, and approved the Mills-Peninsula Health Services grant and funding agreement for the term of January 1, 2014, through December 31, 2016, in the amount of \$600,000 and desires to accept it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that this

Board of Supervisors hereby accepts the \$600,000 grant award from Mills-Peninsula

Health Services on behalf of the County of San Mateo and thanks Mills-Peninsula Heath

Services for its support of the most vulnerable members of the San Mateo County

community.
