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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH
ATIMS, INC. TO INCLUDE INTEGRATION BETWEEN THE JAIL MANAGEMENT
SYSTEM AND THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM, INCREASING
THE AMOUNT BY \$270,840 TO AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,902,640**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County's criminal justice departments have relied upon a single application, Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS), to input, update, and exchange criminal justice client data for more than 22 years; and

WHEREAS, on-going support for CJIS requires knowledge and experience in legacy technology that is not readily available; and

WHEREAS, in 2011, the County engaged the services of a consulting firm to assist in determining an effective data integration solution to replace CJIS; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2012, the County entered into an agreement with ATIMS, Inc. for jail management system (JMS) software, related hardware, services and five years of maintenance in an amount not to exceed \$1,565,800, for a six year, ten month term commencing June 1, 2012 through March 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2013, Amendment One to the agreement was executed which established data exchanges between CJIS and JMS, increasing the

contract amount by \$66,000 to \$1,631,800; and

WHEREAS, both parties now wish to execute a second amendment to include data exchanges needed in order to go-live with JMS, increasing the amount of the contract by \$270,840, from \$1,631,800 to \$1,902,640; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such second amendment and has examined and approved same as to both form and content and desires to enter into same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be, and is hereby authorized and directed to execute Amendment Two to the agreement with ATIMS Inc., for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
