WHEREAS, *Over the course of over four decades, as City Treasurer of Daly City, Anthony J. Zidich has provided an outstanding public service and used his elected office to work tirelessly for the residents of Daly City and the San Mateo County community as a whole; and*

WHEREAS, *Anthony J. Zidich was born and raised in the City and County of San Francisco, attended Sacred Heart Preparatory High School where his skill as a baseball player earned him an induction into that school's Sports Hall of Fame, later joined the United States Army where he was stationed in the City and County of San Francisco during the Korean War and then built a successful realty business specializing in the Westlake neighborhood; and*
