**Subject:** Appointments to the Emergency Medical Care Committee (EMCC)

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommendation for appointments to the Emergency Medical Care Committee (EMCC), each for a term ending March 31, 2020:

- A) Arthur Stellini, representing Police Chiefs; and
- B) Colleen Sasso, representing American Red Cross.

**BACKGROUND:**

The responsibility of the Emergency Medical Care Committee is to review annually each of the ambulance services operating and offered within the County, as well as first aid practices in the County. The Committee establishes and monitors emergency care guidelines, presents recommendations to improve emergency care, and establishes and monitors critical patient treatment and transfer guidelines.

**DISCUSSION:**

Arthur Stellini is a resident of Broadmoor and is Chief of Police of the Broadmoor Police Department.

Colleen Sasso is a resident of Daly City and presently with the American Red Cross.

This appointment contributes to the 2025 Shared Vision statement of a Collaborative Community.
