RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF RETIRED PRINCIPAL AUDITOR-APPRAISER, ROBERT INNES TO AN EXTRA HELP POSITION IN ORDER TO ASSIST IN THE PREPARATION OF ASSESSMENT APPEALS AND APPEALS TO THE SUPERIOR COURT, PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE §7522.56(F) (1), THAT THE APPOINTMENT IS NECESSARY TO FILL A CRITICALLY-NEEDED POSITION BEFORE THE 180 DAY POST-RETIREMENT SEPARATION PERIOD EXPIRES.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Assessor's Office is responsible for determining the assessed value of all taxable property located in San Mateo County and with defending those values in front of the Assessment Appeals Board and in the Courts; and

WHEREAS, retired Principal Auditor-Appraiser Robert Innes has unique skills, expertise, and knowledge in the appraisal and history of certain properties that are being reviewed by the Assessment Appeals Board and the Courts; and

WHEREAS, the knowledge and expertise Robert Innes is able to provide to the Assessor's Office and County Counsel is essential and unattainable from current County personnel; and

WHEREAS, Government Code §7522.56 requires a One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body makes a finding by certifying that the

appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the One-Hundred Eighty (180) day separation period has passed; and

WHEREAS, Robert Innes' services are needed prior to the expiration of the One-Hundred-Eighty (180) day separation period; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this Resolution approving the hiring of retired Principal Auditor-Appraiser Robert Innes to an extra help position in order to provide assistance on assessment appeals and court actions pursuant to Government Code §7522.56(f)(1), that the nature of employment and appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before the post-retirement 180 day separation period expires.
