RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS FOR COUNTY OF SAN MATEO FUN RUN FESTIVAL

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2016, San Mateo County hosted its first Fun Run Festival event as part of the County's Wellness and Employee Engagement initiative, this event encourages employee and their friends and family members to participate in activities that promote health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, various donors provided financial support and other gifts to offset event costs, to provide monetary awards for the top finishers in each age division, and to provide participants with a positive and encouraging environment; and

WHEREAS, Blue Shield of California provided a \$5,000 monetary contribution and Kaiser of Permanente provided in kind donations consisting of participant t-shirts, sunscreen packets, water bottles, and stretch bands; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the participant registration fees will be donated to the County's Charitable Contributions Campaign organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County supports this endeavor to benefit its employees' health and well-being.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County accepts the monetary donations supporting the event on behalf of the County of San Mateo.
