RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING

## *The Child Care Coordinating Council* *for forty years of service to the children of San Mateo County*

**WHEREAS**, in 1972, a Steering Committee began planning for a **Child Care Coordinating Council** and with the assistance of a grant from the United Way, the **Child Care Coordinating Council** incorporated in San Mateo County with offices at the Mental Health Office; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors designated the **Child Care Coordinating Council** as the primary coordinating agency for child care planning and funding in San Mateo County; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the **Child Care Coordinating Council's** mission to create quality child care and preschool opportunities; and

**WHEREAS**, some of the most important **Child Care Coordinating Council** programs include a Parent Resource Center, a Family-to-Family program to train providers in child care and development, a Spanish Speaking Child Care Initiative which increased the number of Spanish-speaking providers for San Mateo County families, a Calworks Toll Free line for Calworks participants to receive resources and referral information, and an initiative to enroll kids in health insurance; and

**WHEREAS**, early childhood education provides a window of opportunity to dramatically shape a child's brain when it is rapidly developing, and studies show that children with higher quality preschool classes have better math and language skills.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and commends the **Child Care Coordinating Council** for their forty years of effort leading to the success for the children and families of San Mateo County.
