Subject: Reconstruction of North Street
[County Project No. RW507; Project File No. E4928000]

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution:

- A) Adopting the plans and specifications, including conformance with prevailing wage scale requirements for the reconstruction of North Street from Stage Road to Pescadero Creek Road – Pescadero Area; and
- B) Authorizing the Director of Public Works to call for sealed proposals to be received by Thursday, July 23, 2015 at 2:30 p.m., in the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.

BACKGROUND:

North Street provides access within the Pescadero community for residents and visitors, is adjacent to the Pescadero Elementary School (School), and is a popular bicycle route. The road's pavement condition rating has dropped to a level which requires reconstruction of the road. The Department held a public meeting on May 20, 2015 at the Pescadero Elementary School to provide an overview of the Project and answer questions about the Project. The Department notified all property owners and residents along North Street and the Pescadero Municipal Advisory Council of the meeting. Additionally, notification of the meeting was available at the School and Puente.

DISCUSSION:

The Project includes the reconstruction of North Street from Stage Road to Pescadero Creek Road in the Pescadero Area, which is approximately 0.92 miles in length. The existing width of North Street varies from 20 to 24 feet and the Project has been designed to retain the existing roadway widths and drainage patterns. The road reconstruction includes cement treating the roadway base, and placing asphalt concrete over the treated base. Aggregate base will be placed in the roadway shoulder areas

where rock or dirt currently exists, where necessary for roadway connectivity, or to maintain existing drainage patterns. Two existing drainage pipes that cross North Street will be replaced due to their current condition. However, the existing drainage patterns will be maintained and the road will continue to rely on surface drainage for the conveyance of storm water. Shared roadway bicycle pavement markings (“sharrows”) will be placed along the length of the Project. In addition, school, pedestrian, and speed advisory signs will be installed, including high visibility yellow ladder type crosswalks, adjacent to the School. Push button flashing pedestrian signs at both sides of the crosswalks by the School will also be installed.

The County Service Area 11 (Pescadero Community Water System) has requested that minor work involving affected water facilities be performed in conjunction with this Project. The plans and specifications for the Project have been prepared and staff is recommending that your Board authorize calling for bids for the proposed work.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the resolution as to form.

Approval of this action will contribute to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Livable Community by improving our roads for use by the traveling public to support livable connected communities.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The estimated cost of construction is \$880,000. The project will be financed as follows:

Road Mitigation Fee Funds	\$560,000
County Service Area 11 (Pescadero Community Water System)*	\$1,500
Total Estimated Cost	\$880,000

*Resolution No. 064550, executed by your Board on June 19, 2001, authorizes the Director of Public Works to enter into agreements with special districts for work less than \$50,000 proposed to be done in conjunction with County road projects.

There is no impact to the General Fund.
