**Subject:** Agreement with Motorola Solutions for radio console equipment and installation

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee to:

- A. Execute an agreement with Motorola Solutions to provide and install Motorola radio consoles, software, and peripheral radio equipment at the Maple Street Correctional Center in an amount not to exceed \$220,823, and
- B. Make modifications to this contract in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

## BACKGROUND:

After acquiring 4.85 acres of land in Redwood City on Maple Street at Blomquist Street, and approving the scope and size of a jail project at that site, the Board approved contracts for jail design, engineering and construction management services. The Board approved a contract with Sundt Layton to construct the Maple Street Correctional Center (MSCC). The construction is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2015. A substantial amount of equipment identified as Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment (FF&E) must be ordered, delivered, and installed in a timely manner in order to operate the facility.

## DISCUSSION:

MSCC will contain a state-of-the-art radio communication network to allow radio contact with staff throughout the building and to allow radio contact across the various law enforcement channels in the County. A well-engineered and installed radio system is essential to maintaining the safety and security of the staff and the facility by providing reliable communication everywhere in and immediately around the MSCC facility. A distributed antenna system for this network will be installed as part of the construction of MSCC and has been previously approved by the Board. This agreement with Motorola Solutions will provide the "smarts and parts" to equip the MSCC radio network with the required equipment, software, and peripherals to optimize the capabilities of the network. The scope of work in the proposed agreement includes providing and installing necessary radio console equipment, software, licenses, consolettes, hand-held radios (10), and chargers.

The County uses Motorola radio equipment exclusively throughout the County. To ensure interoperability with existing radio equipment, waiver of the RFP process is being requested.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the Resolution as to form.

Approval of this Resolution contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Collaborative Community by ensuring a safe and cost effective MSCC facility.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The amount of this agreement is \$220,823. This amount is included in the approved project budget.
