RESOLUTION (A) ESTABLISHING A SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE BOARD TO ASSESS AND DEVELOP SOLUTIONS TO ADDRESS THE IMPACT OF INCREASED AIR TRAFFIC AT SAN CARLOS AIRPORT; (B) APPOINTING SUPERVISORS WARREN SLOCUM AND DON HORSLEY TO THE SUBCOMMITTEE; AND (C) DIRECTING THE SUBCOMMITTEE TO CONTACT AND WORK WITH THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION TO DEVELOP SOLUTIONS TO ADDRESS AIR TRAFFIC IMPACTS AT SAN CARLOS AIRPORT AND TO REVIEW CAPITAL PLANNING AT THE AIRPORT

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County owns and operates a general aviation airport in San Carlos, CA (the Airport); and

WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration (the FAA) plays a major oversight role with respect to the County's management of aviation activities at the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Airport has experienced a significant increase in air traffic, particularly within the last year, which has led to growing concerns expressed by the community, FAA and County staff administering the Airport regarding the impact of this increase; and

WHEREAS, the diverse nature of the potential impacts and related concerns, as well as the FAA's significant oversight role at the airport will require close coordination between the County and the FAA to identify potential solutions; and

WHEREAS, forming a subcommittee of this Board to address these concerns is an important step toward resolving them; and

WHEREAS, Supervisors Warren Slocum and Don Horsley have been engaged in ongoing efforts to address and resolve these concerns and are suited to serve on this subcommittee.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED :

1. That a Subcommittee of the Board is established to address the impact of increased air traffic at San Carlos Airport.
2. That Supervisor Warren Slocum and Supervisor Don Horsley are appointed to the Subcommittee.
3. That the Subcommittee is directed to contact and work with the Federal Aviation Administration to develop solutions to address air traffic impacts at San Carlos Airport and to review capital planning at the Airport.
