Subject: Amendment to the Agreement with Allied Barton for Maple Street Correctional Center construction site security.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt a resolution authorizing the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee to execute an amendment to the agreement with Allied Barton to provide construction site security for the Maple Street Correctional Center, increasing the amount by \$90,000 to an amount not to exceed \$190,000, and extending the term through March 31, 2016.

BACKGROUND:

In December 2010, the County acquired a 4.85 acre parcel of land located on Maple Street in Redwood City. In October 2011, the Board of Supervisors approved a jail project at the site and authorized the Sheriff to proceed with a replacement jail facility with a rated bed capacity of 488-522, an additional 88 non-secure transitional beds, and a first floor warm shell. On April 28, 2015, the Board approved the Maple Street Correctional Center (MSCC) Phase 2 – 1st Floor Build-Out (Build-Out). In this phase, the area initially designated as a warm shell will be constructed and equipped as part of the secure area of the jail.

DISCUSSION:

Allied Barton, the existing security contractor for the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office, has been under separate contract to provide construction site security during the building of MSCC. This security has provided protection against vandalism and theft at the construction site, thereby saving the County money and time. It is anticipated that the Sheriff's Office will move inmates into MSCC during March 2016. When that occurs, the facility will be secured and staffed 24/7 by Sheriff's Office personnel. Prior to that time, it is essential that site security be maintained to prevent unauthorized access and criminal acts at the facility.

Approval of this resolution will authorize the Sheriff or Sheriff's designee to execute the amendment to the agreement with Allied Barton in order to extend their security services through the end of March 2016. The amendment will also increase the contract amount by \$90,000 to an amount not to exceed \$190,000. The full amount of the amendment is included in the approved Sheriff's Office Jail Planning Bureau Budget.

County Counsel has reviewed and approved the resolution as to form.

Approval of this resolution contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Collaborative Community by ensuring a safe and cost effective MSCC facility.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The amendment to the agreement with Allied Barton will increase the amount by \$90,000 to an amount not to exceed \$190,000, as well as extend the term through March 31, 2016. The full amount of this amendment is included in the approved Sheriff's Office Jail Planning Bureau Budget.
