Location	Incident Period	Damage Description
Mirada Road, Miramar	Jan 18-25	Road badly damaged by high surf. Asphalt peeled from exist road surface
Mirada Road, Miramar	Jan 18- 25	Bluff failure within road right of way on ocean side of the road and loss of road near ped bridge
Entrada Way, La Honda	Feb 3 - 7	Storm conditions rerouted Creek. Storm flows redirected directly towards road bank away from designed flow channel & culvert. Culvert estimated at 14 ft. in diameter. Road at immediate risk and Road Commissioner Authority to close the road would be possible without an immediate response.
Scenic Drive, La Honda	Jan 18 -25	Failed road as a result of winter storms cumulative rains causing significant land movement The road is currently closed at Scenic Drive. Alternate routes are narrow and steep and it has not yet been established whether any of those routes are at risk.
Upper Gazos Creek Road	Feb 3-7	Winter storms caused mud flows and tree falls across road
Lower Gazos Creek Road	Jan 18-25	3 sites – Winter storm flows caused erosion of creek banks causing road failures. Road narrowing to critically narrow widths. Temporary closures were required.
Alpine Road, Los Trancos	Feb 3-7	Winter storm rains caused mudslide across road causing road closure The road has been opened but is at risk for future closures caused by additional debris flows. The road is the sole access for several homes..
Alpine Trail, Ladera	Feb 3-7	Winter storms caused downed trees, failing trail, water lines, road and sewer line at risk. County infrastructure includes the road and the trail. Utilities are maintained by other entities. However utility failures present a significant risk for additional and considerable trail and road damage.
Portola Road	Feb 16	Failed twin 60" corrugated metal culverts. Shoulder erosion has occurred and is advancing towards the road.
Cloverdale Road, Old La Honda	Feb 3-7	Winter storm record rain fall generated debris flows. Roads blocked. Emergency response required to reopen roads
