BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A REVENUE AGREEMENT WITH SOUTH BAY RECYCLING TO PROVIDE A SUPPORTED EMPLOYMENT WORK PROGRAM FOR VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES PARTICIPANTS WITH EMPLOYMENT BARRIERS THROUGH SOUTH BAY RECYCLING'S RECYCLING PROGRAM, FOR THE TERM MARCH 14, 2017 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2020, IN AN ANTICIPATED REIMBURSEMENT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$6,857,659 FROM SOUTH BAY RECYCLING TO THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO.

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County residents with barriers to employment are in need of training in order to obtain jobs and Vocational Rehabilitation Services (VRS) of the Human Services Agency is collaborating with the recycling industry to provide training and employment opportunities to the hard-to-employ population; and

WHEREAS, with your Board's support of this revenue agreement, VRS participants with employment barriers will be placed into a paid job training program, which will open up job opportunities, and lead to self-sufficiency and South Bay Recycling (SBR) agrees to reimburse VRS for wages paid to the participants, incentive bonuses, the cost of supervision and administrative costs anticipated up to \$6,857,659 over the three year term of March 14, 2017 through December 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this work program is designed to serve 50 or more participants annually, the actual number could be higher or lower and the amount reimbursed to

VRS will vary based on the number of participants hired by SBR into the work program, but reimbursements shall be based on actual costs associated with wages, incentive bonuses, the cost of supervision and administration costs to operate the program; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and contents and desires to enter into the same; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
