RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO: A) APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FEDERAL FUNDS AVAILABLE FOR FY 2016-17 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20,000 THROUGH THE JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS FOR THE EVIDENCE-BASED TRAINING PROJECT; AND B) PROVIDE MATCHING FUNDS REQUIRED FOR THIS GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,222

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of

California, that

WHEREAS, the Probation Department desires to participate in the Evidence-Based Practices Training Project supported by the federal Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) and administered by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC); and

WHEREAS, the Chief Probation Officer or Chief's designee submitted the Evidence-Based Training Project application for FY 2016-17 in the amount of \$20,000 administered by BSCC due October 12, 2016 in order to meet application deadlines; and

WHEREAS, the Department is able to provide the matching fund in the amount of \$2,222 required for this grant; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with the form of a Resolution and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into said Resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Chief Probation Officer or his designee are hereby authorized to:

- A. Apply for and accept \$20,000 for the Evidence-Based Training Project administered by the BSCC funding and sign the grant agreement with BSCC, including any amendments thereto on behalf of the County of San Mateo; and
  - B. Provide matching funds required for this grant in the amount of \$2,222; and
- C. Abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the BSCC; and
- D. Certify that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
