RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation for the appointment of Supervisor David J. Canepa as San Mateo County's Alternate Director, to the Board of Directors of the California State Association of Counties (CSAC).

BACKGROUND:

The California State of Association of Counties (CSAC), represents county government before the California Legislature, administrative agencies and the federal government. They have a Board of Directors that is comprised of one primary and one alternate member for each of the California's 58 Counties. Approval of this item would make Supervisor David J. Canepa the alternate appointee to the CSAC Board of Directors.
