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MEASURE K: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING:

A) PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR WUNDERLICH PARK CARRIAGE HOUSE IMPROVEMENTS; AND B) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO CALL FOR SEALED BIDS ON MARCH 8, 2018 AT 2:00 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND C) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING, UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE DATE AND TIME ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, plans and specifications have been reviewed and approved by the Director of Public Works for Wunderlich Park Carriage House Improvements, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay no less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract; and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Parks Department has developed plans to make improvements to the Wunderlich Park Carriage House to improve access in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient **Measure K** funds to fund this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The plans and specifications for the aforesaid project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, are hereby approved and adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.
2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay no less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of workman needed to execute the contract.
3. The Department of Public Works, or his designee, is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and the Director of Public Works is authorized to call for bids and to set the bid opening date and time on March 8, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. in the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Deputy Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
4. The Director of Public Works, or his designee, is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) days beyond the date and time originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.

5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the notice inviting sealed bids to be published for two (2) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
