

Attachment “A” –Proposed Parking Restriction and Public Input Summary

Authorizing the establishment of a “No Parking” zone on El Nido Road:

Along the south side of El Nido Road beginning approximately 10 feet east of the easterly property line of 103 El Nido Road and continuing east for a distance of approximately 60 feet onto the south side of Los Trancos Circle.

Discussion:

The Department of Public Works (Department) received requests from members of the public as well as the Woodside Fire Protection District for a “No Parking” zone on El Nido Road in Los Trancos. The Department evaluated the intersection of El Nido Road and Los Trancos Circle and determined that the road is narrow and parking along this stretch of road constricts the flow of traffic. The purpose of the “No Parking” zone is to clarify the parking restrictions at the intersection and improve access for emergency services vehicles from Los Trancos Circle, Vista Verde Way, and El Nido Road.

Key Facts:

- The proposed “No Parking” Zone is necessary to limit parking on narrow portions of the road as it impedes the movement of emergency and service vehicles.
- 1 objection received, 3 supports received
- Objector voiced concern over the potential spillover effect on adjacent street, Los Trancos Circle.
- The Department will continue to monitor the intersection to determine if additional “No Parking” zones are needed.

Staff Recommendations:

The Department has evaluated the request and determined that the “No Parking” zone is necessary to enhance overall driving conditions.

Establish a “No Parking” zone at the locations per the request.
