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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH HARDER & COMPANY COMMUNITY RESEARCH TO PROVIDE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AND DATABASE SUPPORT FOR THE USE OF SOCIAL SOLUTIONS EFFORTS TO OUTCOMES (ETO) DATABASE FOR THE TERM OF JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2019, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$280,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County Manager's Office has contracted with Harder & Company Community Services since 2013 to help provide technical assistance and database support for the use of Social Solutions Efforts to Outcomes (ETO); and

WHEREAS, Harder & Company has been instrumental in assisting County departments serving the public safety realignment and Unified Reentry populations in building out ETO to track services to these populations; and

WHEREAS, the County Manager's Office seeks to use Harder's services to continue expanding the use of ETO in the tracking of County services to the Unified Reentry population, and other justice involved groups, and their services will be needed for an upcoming evaluation of the County's implementation of public safety realignment; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into a contract with Harder & Company to provide such services for a maximum amount not to exceed \$305,000 for the term not to exceed December 31, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Request for Proposal process is hereby waived; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the County Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute an agreement with Harder & Company for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, for a maximum agreement amount not to exceed \$280,000 for a term not to exceed December 31, 2019, pursuant to the County's standard contract provisions; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the County Manger or his designee is further authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
