GSA ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR THE PREMISES AT 8865 LA HONDA ROAD, LA

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of
California, that

WHEREAS, California Business and Professions Code section 23958.4
provides that, upon the request of an applicant for a license to sell liquor, when the
granting of the license would result in the "undue concentration" of such establishments,
the County must make a determination as to whether the public convenience or
necessity would be served by the granting of such license; and;

WHEREAS, the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control has concluded that
there is an undue concentration of licenses already issued in the census tract where the
property is located; and;

WHEREAS, the County has received such a request from GSA Enterprises,
Inc. for the premises at 8865 La Honda Road, La Honda, California; and;

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed the request, and determined to grant it;

1. The public convenience or necessity would be served by the granting of an Alcoholic Beverage License to GSA Enterprises, Inc. for the premises at 8865 La Honda Road, La Honda, California.




