- 1. Stop Signs be installed at the following locations:
 - Fifth Avenue (County Road No. 23) at Fair Oaks Avenue (County Road No.
 1416-B), North Fair Oaks Area

A stop sign on northeast-bound FIFTH AVENUE to direct traffic to stop at the intersection of FAIR OAKS AVENUE.

Fifth Avenue (County Road No. 23) at Fair Oaks Avenue (County Road No.
 1416-B), North Fair Oaks Area

A stop sign on southwest-bound FIFTH AVENUE to direct traffic to stop at the intersection of FAIR OAKS AVENUE.

 The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
