TO IMPLEMENT THE APPROVED PROJECTS AND CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES
SPECIFIED IN THE APPLICATIONS EFFECTIVE UNTIL RESCINDED

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48690 et seq. authorize the Dapartment of Resources, Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions for implementation of their used oil program; and

WHEREAS, in promoting this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Used Oil Payment Program require, among other things, an applicant's governing body to declare certain authorizations by Resolution specific only to the Used Oil Payment Program; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Mateo will serve as lead grant applicant for the

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of the Health System or designee is authorized to execute all necessary applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and all documents necessary to secure funds and to implement the approved projects and carry out the purposes specified in the applications effective until rescinded.
