**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A DROP-OFF ZONE IN BROADMOOR**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 and Section 7.28.020 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones that prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a five minute drop-off zone be created as noted herein; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs in the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

1. A Drop-Off Zone (5-minute) is established at the following location:

➤ 377 Eighty-Seventh Street (County Road No. 126), Broadmoor

On the southerly side of EIGHTY-SEVENTH STREET commencing at a point 641 feet easterly of the intersection of WASHINGTON STREET and extending easterly a distance of 27 feet, more or less.


