**SUBJECT:** Appropriation Transfer Request

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt a Resolution approving an Appropriation Transfer Request in the amount of \$150,000 from reserves to various accounts to purchase the replacement/upgrade hardware, software and implementation of the Storage Area Network (SAN) appliances.

### **BACKGROUND:**

The Sheriff's Office manages and maintains critical Information Technology (IT) systems for regional law enforcement. A number of the elements that comprise these systems have reached end of life and need replacement and or upgrades. These systems include the Storage Area Network (SAN) appliances, the data back-up and recovery system and the virtual server environment.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Given the critical nature of law enforcement systems, these systems need to be highly available in order to maintain public safety. The present NetApp SAN appliances that house a number of these systems have reached their data capacity limits and are also prohibitively expensive to maintain given the age of the appliances. With increased age and decreasing warranty availability, there is a risk of data loss and or system downtime.

New NetApp SAN appliances with a larger capacity will provide current and future applications the space they need to continue to function properly. By replacing the current SAN with new NetApp hardware, it will have the cost of vendor support, increase reliability and remain compatible with existing systems. All of these are important factors in ensuring that critical law enforcement data systems remain highly available.

With the replacement of the NetApp SAN, the current back-up and recovery system for the Sheriff's Office also needs to be replaced and upgraded to provide the ability to restore data in the event of a total system failure.

This funding will allow the Sheriff's Office to standardize the virtual server technology, upgrade the versions to current supportable levels, and provide out-year warranty support allowing for lower overall support costs.

The Appropriation Transfer Request provides funding for these purchases and other project costs.

Approval of the ATR contributes to the Shared Vision 2025 outcome of a Collaborative Community because it demonstrates multiple County departments working together to ensure critical law enforcement systems are available.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

The Appropriation Transfer Request provides funding for the replacement/upgrade projects and includes personnel costs associated with the upgrades/replacements. The total cost of these projects is expected to total \$150,000. The ATR also includes funding for the virtual server project including upgrades, support and maintenance. Funding for these projects will originate from the Sheriff's Office Reserves.
