RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT TWO TO THE AGREEMENT WITH AMERICAN MEDICAL RESPONSE WEST FOR ASSESSMENT AND TRANSPORT OF PERSONS WITH BEHAVIORAL EMERGENCIES AND FOR THE TRANSPORT OF MENTAL HEALTH CLIENTS, EXTENDING THE TERM FROM JUNE 30, 2009 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2009, AND INCREASING THE AGREEMENT MAXIMUM BY \$81,000 FROM \$1,296,000 TO A NEW MAXIMUM OF \$1,377,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement on December 7, 2005, for the assessment and transport of patients with behavioral emergencies and for the transport of prescheduled mental health clients; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement was amended on February 10, 2009, to increase the maximum obligation by \$162,000 for a new maximum obligation of \$1,296,000 and extend the term through June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Agreement to extend the term through September 30, 2009, and increase the amount by \$81,000 increasing the Agreement maximum obligation from \$1,296,000 to \$1,377,000.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the

President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to

execute Amendment Two to the Agreement for and behalf of the County of San Mateo.
