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RESOLUTION:

1. ACCEPTING THE FY 2011 NATIONAL JUSTICE INFORMATION SHARING (JIS) INITIATIVE GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,240, FOR THE PERIOD OF OCTOBER 1, 2011 TO MARCH 31, 2013; AND
2. AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF OR SHERIFF'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH THE GRANT INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO AGREEMENTS, AMENDMENTS, AND GRANT ASSURANCES

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) National Justice Information Sharing (JIS) Initiative works collaboratively with key stakeholders and national partner organizations to identify critical issues and problems, and provide resources in response to emerging challenges in law enforcement, courts, corrections, reentry human/social services and tribal justice; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office applied for and was awarded the FY 2011 National Justice Information Sharing (JIS) Initiative grant in the amount of \$90,240, for the period of October 1, 2011 to March 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, funding from the JIS Initiative will be used to develop the Elected Officials Threat Monitoring System; and

WHEREAS, the Elected Officials Threat Monitoring System project, piloted by the Northern California Regional Intelligence Center (NCRIC), will leverage technology to establish a national framework for collecting and analyzing threat data for local and visiting elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Elected Officials Threat Monitoring System will improve and

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enhance the ability of law enforcement and fusion centers to effectively and efficiently share relevant threat data amongst agencies;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the:

1. Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County of San Mateo, hereby accepts the FY 2011 National Justice Information Sharing (JIS) Initiative grant award in the amount of \$90,240; and
2. Sheriff of Sheriff's designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents in connection with this grant including but not limited to contracts, agreements, amendments, and grant assurances.
