**RESOLUTION APPROVING PROCESS, TIMELINE AND STRATEGIES TO
ELIMINATE THE GENERAL FUND STRUCTURAL IMBALANCE
BY FISCAL YEAR 2013**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County faces a structural budget imbalance in its General Fund; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of current and future generations and the most vulnerable members of our community to eliminate this structural imbalance in a thoughtful and strategic manner and with a long-term perspective; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has adopted a set of Budget Balancing Principles to create a collaborative framework for exploring all options to eliminate the structural imbalance;

WHEREAS, the County Manager has submitted to the Board of Supervisors a process, timeline and Budget Balancing Strategies for its consideration;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the process, timeline and Budget Balancing Strategies will be used to develop solutions toward eliminating the General Fund structural budget imbalance by Fiscal Year 2013.


