RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASING AGENT TO PURCHASE A LENCO BEARCAT G3 TACTICAL EMERGENCY RESPONSE VEHICLE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,000, NO NET COUNTY COST

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Law Enforcement Tactical Teams received funding from the FY 2010 Urban Area Security Initiative Grant (UASI) for the purchase of a Lenco BearCat Tactical Emergency Response Vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Lenco armored tactical vehicle is capable of operating in urban, rural, and rugged environments; and

WHEREAS, Lenco manufacturer armored vehicles for law enforcement, military, and government agencies, that are integral in responding to high risk environments including, active shooters, hostage situations, and terrorist related attacks; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to waive the competitive bid process on the basis that Lenco is recognized worldwide as a leader in the manufacturing of tactical armored vehicles; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors waives the request for proposal process and authorizes the purchasing agent to issue a purchase order with Lenco Industries, Inc. for provision of a BearCat G3 Tactical Emergency Response Vehicle.
