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RESOLUTION: A) ADOPTING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH FEDERAL PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS, FOR THE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OF THE MADERA LANE BRIDGE PROJECT IN THE SAN GREGORIO AREA OF UNINCORPORATED SAN MATEO COUNTY; AND B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED BIDS TO BE RECEIVED BY THURSDAY, MAY 24, 2018 AT 2:30PM IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY MANAGER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of

California, that

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation's (Caltrans) Local

Assistance Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program (Program) defines a process that

local agencies can follow for bridge preventative maintenance projects to be eligible for

federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Department has complied with the Program requirements and

identified the bridge preventative maintenance projects to proceed with for federal

funding; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications, dated March 20, 2017, were previously

prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Bridge Preventative

Maintenance Program for Various Bridges (Bridges Project), and said plans and

specifications were filed in the office of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on June 13, 2017, at 2:30p.m., open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Plans and Specifications; and

WHERAS, a single bid was received for the Bridges Project and was referred to the Department of Public Works for analysis and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the bid received was submitted by Myers and Sons Construction, LP, in the amount of \$1,196,338 based on an estimate of the amount of Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" work to be done. The bid was comprised of \$276,502 and \$919,836 for Schedule "A" and Schedule "B", respectively. Due to the Federal Funding available and cost, this Board awarded the Schedule "A" portion of the Bridges Project with the anticipation that the County would re-evaluate the work described in Schedule "B" and revise the described work or re-advertise the Schedule "B" work, which was the Madera Lane Bridge portion of the Bridges Project; and

WHEREAS, the Madera Lane Bridge Project (Project) consists of replacement of existing concrete girders and barrier railing, and repairing spalled concrete on the Madera Lane Bridge over El Corte de Madera Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highways Administration through Caltrans has provided Federal Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program (BPMP) Funds for engineering and environmental services for this Project and will provide funding for the construction of the Project; and

WHEREAS, Plans and Specifications, dated April 20, 2018 were prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the U.S. Department of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract; and

WHEREAS, this Board has considered and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

- 1. The plans and specifications dated April 20, 2018, for the aforesaid project are hereby approved and are adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said improvements.
- Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the U.S.
 Department of Labor on federally funded projects, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.
- 3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals and to set the bid opening date and time on or before 2:30 p.m., Thursday, May 24, 2018 in the office of the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood

City, California. Said bids will be received by the Deputy Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Manager's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.

- 4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
- 5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a newspaper receiving wide local circulation, published in the County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
