RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH MULTICULTURAL INSTITUTE TO PROVIDE STREET-BASED OUTREACH EMPLOYMENT MATCHING SERVICES FOR DAY LABORERS AND EMPLOYERS FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2018 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2020, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$332,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, since May 2006, the County of San Mateo has funded a Day

Laborer Street Outreach Program which provides structure, vocational training, and
support for the day labor community and significantly improves public relations in the

North Fair Oaks Neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency (HSA) issued a Request for

Proposals (RFP) in January 2018, seeking organizations that could provide a Day

Laborer Outreach Program in the North Fair Oaks region of San Mateo County and

Multicultural Institute was selected as the vendor that would best meet the needs of the

County; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an Agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, in an amount of \$332,000 for the term of July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020 to provide street-based outreach employment matching services for day laborers and employers; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such Agreement and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the same.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or his/her designee is authorized to execute amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the Agreement and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
