BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING:** 

- A) THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH BUGLER CONSTRUCTION, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$685,310 FOR THE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE OF THE MADERA LANE BRIDGE PROJECT IN THE SAN GREGORIO AREA OF SAN MATEO COUNTY; AND B) THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO:
- 1. EXECUTE SUBSEQUENT CHANGE ORDERS TO GRANT TIME EXTENSIONS FOR PROJECT COMPLETION AND PAYMENT UP TO A MAXIMUM AGGREGATE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$68,531, OR APPROXIMATELY 10% OF THE AGREEMENT AMOUNT; AND
  - 2. FILE A NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR A CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT CATEGORICAL EXEMPTION

**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation's (Caltrans) Local
Assistance Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program (Program) defines a process that
local agencies can follow for bridge preventative maintenance projects to be eligible for
federal funding; and

WHEREAS, the Department has complied with the Program requirements and identified the bridge preventative maintenance projects to proceed with for federal funding; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications, dated March 20, 2017, were previously prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program for Various Bridges (Bridges Project), which included improvements to Alpine Road Bridge, Madera Lane Bridge and Stage Road Bridge, and

said plans and specifications were filed in the office of the Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on June 13, 2017, at 2:30p.m., open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said plans and specifications; and

**WHERAS,** a single bid was received for the Bridges Project and was referred to the Department of Public Works for analysis and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the single bid received was submitted by Myers and Sons

Construction, LP, in the amount of \$1,196,338 based on an estimate of the amount of

Schedule "A" and Schedule "B" work to be done. The bid was comprised of \$276,502

and \$919,836 for Schedule "A" and Schedule "B", respectively. Due to the Federal

Funding available and cost, this Board awarded the Schedule "A" portion of the Bridges

Project with the anticipation that the County would re-evaluate the work described in

Schedule "B" and revise the described work or re-advertise the Schedule "B" work,

which is the Madera Lane Bridge portion of the Bridges Project; and

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2018, this Board adopted Resolution No. 075862 which resolution adopted the plans and specifications, including conformance with Federal prevailing wage scale requirements and called for sealed proposals for the Preventative Maintenance for Madera Lane Bridge Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works did issue a call for sealed proposals to be received at the office of the County Manager / Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California,

until the hour of 2:30 p.m., Thursday, May 24, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works did cause the notice of inviting sealed proposals to be published three (3) times in the Examiner Peninsula Newspaper, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and obtained an affidavit of said publication; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Clerk of this Board of Supervisors did, in public on May 24, 2018, at 2:30p.m., open and examine all sealed bids that were received in the specified time for the doing of the work referred to in said Plans and Specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board of Supervisors has caused an analysis of said bids to be made by the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo, and has, in open session, fully reviewed and considered said sealed proposals and the analysis thereof; and

WHEREAS, the only bid received was submitted by Bugler Construction, in the amount of \$685,310 based on an estimate of the amount of work to be done; and

WHEREAS, Department of Public Works staff has determined that this Project qualifies for a Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines for Implementation, which provides that repair and maintenance of existing streets and highways is exempt from review.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

 It is in the best interest of the County of San Mateo to award the agreement for the Preventative Maintenance for the Madera Lane Bridge Project to:

- 2. The County of San Mateo shall enter into a written agreement with Bugler Construction, for the completion of said work as required by the Plans and Specifications adopted by this Board of Supervisors, as herein before mentioned, which Plans and Specifications are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works of the County of San Mateo.
- 3. The President of this Board of Supervisors shall be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Bugler Construction, for the doing of said work described therein, subject to the Department of Public Works' receipt and approval of the Faithful Performance Surety Bond ("Performance Bond") and the Labor and Material Surety Bond ("Payment Bond") required to be posted by said Contractor with the County of San Mateo in connection therewith.
- 4. The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to execute change orders related to said work for payment not exceeding \$68,531 in aggregate.
- 5. All payments to the Contractor shall be in accordance with the Plans and Specifications, and other agreement documents. Aggregate payment to the Contractor shall not exceed \$753,841 without this Board's approval.
- 6. The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, County of San Mateo, is hereby

- authorized and directed to attest the signature of the President of this Board of Supervisors to said written agreement.
- 7. The Director of Public Works is hereby authorized to file a Notice of Exemption for a California Environmental Quality Act Categorical Exemption.

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
