

Attachment “A” – Proposed Parking Restriction and Public Input Summary

Authorizing the establishment of a No Parking zone on the west side and a No Oversized Vehicle zone on the east side of Airport Street as shown on attached map to provide additional space for cyclists and pedestrians.

Location: A No Parking zone along the west side of Airport street from the northerly 850 Airport Street driveway continuing north to Cypress Avenue, for a distance of approximately 4900 feet, and a No Oversized Vehicles zone along the east side of Airport street beginning at the intersection with Cornell Avenue and continuing northerly to the intersection with Cypress Avenue, for a distance of approximately 8130 feet.

Establish a No Parking zone and a No Oversized Vehicle zone.

Discussion:

The Department has evaluated the request and determined that No Parking and No Oversized Vehicle parking is necessary to improve safety for pedestrians and cyclists.

Key Facts:

- Restricting parking at this location will improve the conditions for cyclists and pedestrians using this roadway.
- Reduce the trash and illegal discharge of human wastes in the ditch alongside Airport Street.
- There are five objections and twenty-one in support for this item.
- Those in support cite the enhanced space for pedestrians and cyclists as well as reduced blight.
- Some who are opposed are concerned about limited parking for residents and business patrons. Others in opposition feel that the No Oversized parking zone should be a complete no parking zone along the entire length of Airport Street.

Establish a no parking zone and a no oversized vehicle parking zone
