**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “NO PARKING” ZONE,  
ALONG THE NORTH SIDE OF SEMICIRCULAR ROAD BEGINNING AT THE  
INTERSECTION OF SEMICIRCULAR ROAD AND FIFTH AVENUE AND CONTINUING  
EAST FOR A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 180 FEET, IN THE UNINCORPORATED  
AREA OF REDWOOD CITY**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code section 22500 et seq. and Section 7.30.010 of the County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish “no parking” zones and associated signs and markings; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Public Works (Department) received requests from members of the community for a “no parking” zone on Semicircular Road in the unincorporated area of Redwood City; and

**WHEREAS**, the location of this requested parking restriction is located on a sidewalk near Garfield Elementary School and is along a designated as a “Safe Routes to School” route; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the lack of parking in this neighborhood, some vehicles are illegally parked preventing the flow of traffic and/or reducing the visibility for pedestrians crossing at the marked crosswalk; and

**WHEREAS**, property owners on adjacent blocks, extending a minimum of 300 feet from the proposed parking restriction were notified and responded; four in favor and

one opposed to the proposed restrictions; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a “No Parking” zone be established as noted herein; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that:

A “No Parking” zone, be established at the following location:

- Semicircular Road (County Road No. 30) Redwood City along the north side of Semicircular Road approximately 30 feet east of the intersection of Fifth Avenue continuing east for a distance of approximately 180 feet.
