

## **Attachment “A”–Proposed Parking Restriction**

Adopt a resolution amending the designation of No Parking Zones in the public right-of-way on Waverly Avenue and 5th Avenue in North Fair Oaks, unincorporated Redwood City Area.

### **Location: Fifth Avenue and Waverly Avenue, North Fair Oaks Area**

Establish No Parking Zones in the public right-of-way on Waverly Avenue and 5th Avenue in North Fair Oaks.

#### **Discussion:**

There was demonstrated support by the community for no parking zones on Fifth Avenue and Waverly Avenue during the plan review process for the Waverly Place development on Waverly Avenue. The Department of Public Works (DPW) has determined that the No Parking Zones are necessary to modify the intersections to improve the right turn onto Waverly Avenue and the merge zone onto 5th Avenue.

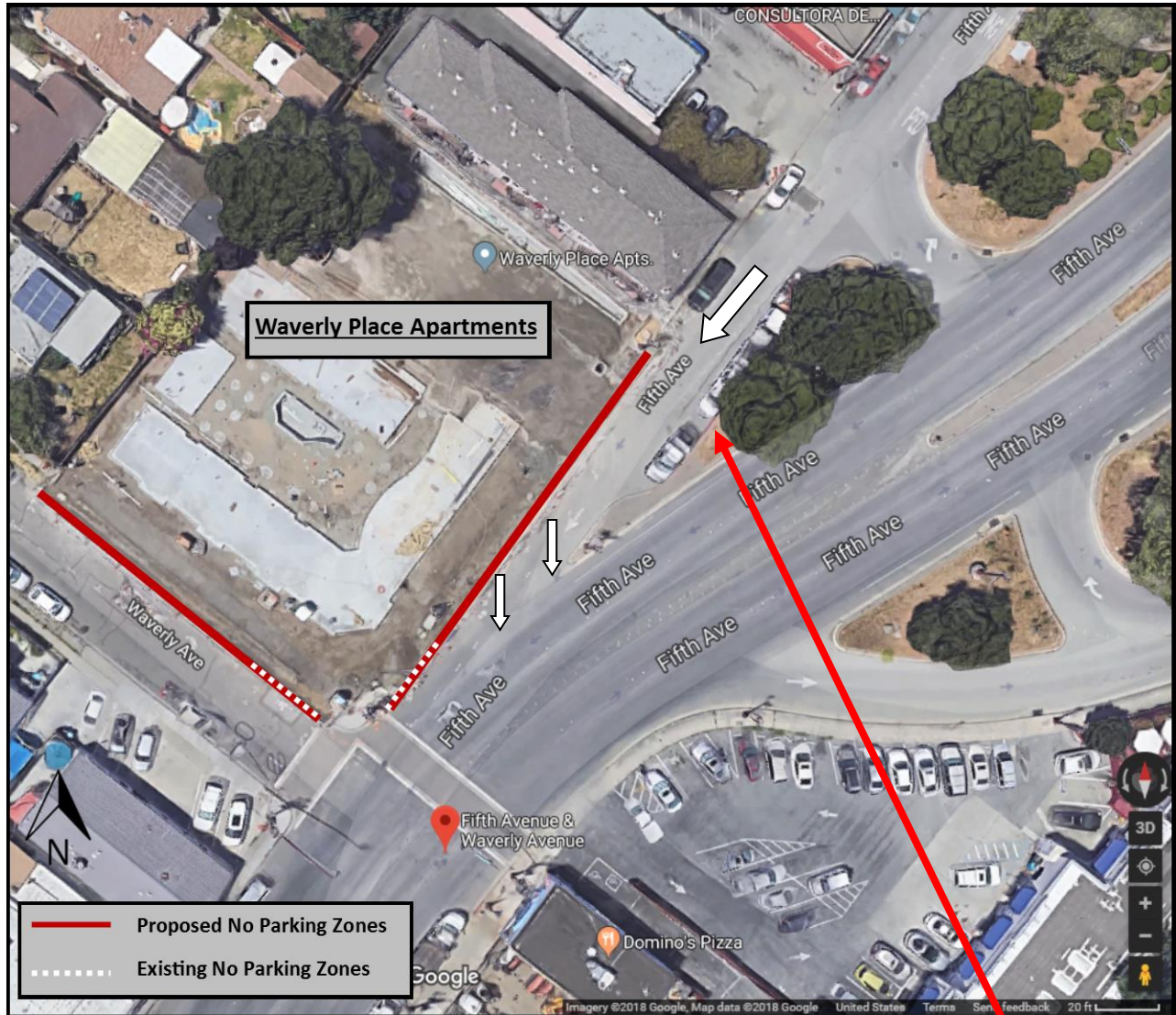
#### **Key Facts:**

- DPW did not send out notices to 300 ft of this location because this was a condition of approval for the project based on community feedback, so it was already vetted through a public process.
- DPW was asked about these parking restrictions at the North Fair Oaks Community Council meeting on April 26, 2018 and informed the Council that the parking restrictions would be presented to the Board of Supervisors for their consideration in June 2018
- Restricting parking at this location, will improve traffic flow and safety on Waverly Avenue and 5th Avenue.

#### **Staff Recommendations:**

Establish no parking zones as shown on the attached map

Additional modification not requiring a board action:

- Relocate parking to this side of street in the parking bay.
- Add a merge lane.
